Cabrillo College is a mid-sized public college that is based just south of Santa Cruz, in Aptos, CA with a satellite school in Watsonville, CA. In total they have over 14k students enrolled.

CLIENT ISSUE/CHALLENGE

- Cabrillo College in Watsonville, CA decided to remodel their campus bathrooms, but needed a solution that would:
 - Ensure longevity of new bathroom partitions, and would
 - Give their standard baked enamel painted stalls a stainless steel appearance
 - Protect new partitions from graffiti vandalism

GRAFFITI SHIELD SOLUTION I METAL SHIELD

- Opaque graffiti abatement film that replicates the look of stainless steel
- Installation similar to traditional anti-graffiti film
- Proprietary adhesive that cleanly releases from the surface but withstands removal attempts from general public
- Protects the surface from future damage while covering up any existing vandalism
- Precut pieces with unique part numbers for quick and easy identification and replacement
- Installation required approximately 300 square feet of custom fit Metal Shield in 10 bathrooms across campus



PROJECT OUTCOME

- Significantly prolonged impact on the appearance of the restrooms
- Significant savings over the costs of purchasing stainless steel stalls
- Film replacement and vandalism overall has gone down tremendously
- Graffiti Shield materials specified for the next renovation on College's main campus
